FOR PURCHASE OF HEMODIALYSIS MACHINES**

16 June 2014, Pasir Gudang, Johor: Malaysia Marine and Heavy Engineering Sdn Bhd (MMHE), a subsidiary of Malaysia Marine and Heavy Engineering Holdings Berhad, together with 28 of its subcontractor partners; presented a cheque for RM 226,500.00 to the *Hospital Waqaf An-Nur Pasir Gudang* for the purchase of five (5) hemodialysis machines and supporting equipment.

This special Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) project by MMHE and its subcontractor partners, was conceived to commemorate MMHE's 40th anniversary celebration in 2013. MMHE and its subcontractors hope their contribution will help supplement the hospital's existing renal treatment facilities and enable *Wakaf An-Nur* to carry out its work more effectively.
