MHB MD & CEO Conferred DSDK Award by Kedah Palace

In conjunction with the official birthday of His Majesty the Sultan of Kedah, DYMM Al-Sultan Almu'tasimu Billahi Muhibuddin Tuanku Alhaj Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah Ibni Almarhum Sultan Badlishah; the MD & CEO of Malaysia Marine and Heaving Engineering Holdings Berhad (MHB), Tn Hj Abu Fitri Abdul Jalil was today conferred the *Anugerah Darjah Datuk Setia Diraja Kedah (DSDK)* which carries the title of *Dato'*.

The award conferment took place at the *Balai Penghadapan, Istana Anak Bukit, Alor Setar* where the MD & CEO of Malaysia's national yard for fabrication and heavy engineering services received his Dato'ship, alongside other civil service and military officials, community leaders and captains of industry.

Dato' Haji Abu Fitri Abdul Jalil, a Malaysian aged 50, was appointed to the Board of MHB as a Non-Independent, Non-Executive Director on 1 February 2015. He assumed the position of MD & CEO of MHB on 1 March 2015. Dato' Hj Abu Fitri is the Chairman of several subsidiaries and jointly controlled entities within the MHB Group.

Prior to joining MHB, Dato' Hj Abu Fitri was VP of Offshore Business in MISC Bhd (MHB's parent company), a position he assumed in March 2013. He joined PETRONAS in 1991 and has held various positions in Malaysia and overseas. Dato' Hj Abu Fitri graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemical Engineering from California State University, USA in 1987.
